BACKGROUND

Within the approved 2013 – 2014 biennial budget, the Clark County District Court has planned, included and projected for numerous ongoing revenue, expenditure and service relationships with both internal county and external entities. If each of these agreements were submitted for BOCC approval, there would be a significant increase in staff report activity and considerable delay in the processing of agreement instruments. For overall efficiency within approved budgetary constraints it makes operational sense to delegate signature authority, formally and officially, to the County Administrator to achieve an appropriate level of executive oversight, as is currently done in the approved biennial budget resolution for grants. Historically, this delegation of authority has been granted to the County Administrator with success.
