BACKGROUND

The Washington State Department of Ecology administers the Community Litter Cleanup Program, which has provided limited funding support statewide for litter pickup and illegal dump site cleanup since 1998. Clark County has been a recipient of this funding since 1998 as well. If the legislature grants Ecology full funding from the Waste Reduction, Recycling and Litter Control Account in the state's 2013-2015 biennium budget, an anticipated \$3,200,000 will be available across the state for the CLCP. Ecology does require that the application is submitted in concert with the county's solid waste planning authority. If awarded, this funding will be used to supplement local funds already within the approved 2013-2014 District Court Work Program budget as well as contribute to the CLCP efforts by Camas and other departments/agencies.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH – District Court and Environmental Services have a long history of working with community partners to utilize this funding source for the benefit and improvement of the whole county.

BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

This proposal is budget neutral. The request adds approximately \$85,556 in expenditure authority with a revenue offset of \$85,556 for 2013-2015. If this request is approved and the grant is awarded, we will provide the exact award amounts and ask the Board to amend the budget accordingly during the next regularly scheduled supplemental.
