SPECIFIC REQUEST: Establishment of County Road Project (CRP) No. 312522 NE 10th Avenue (NE 141st Street to 149th Street) project and approval of the Notice to Contractors to advertise for bid.

BACKGROUND:

This project will improve NE 10th Avenue (NE 141st Street to NE 149th Street) to a standard 2-lane collector with center turn lane, bike lanes, sidewalks, curb, gutter, and shoulders. Stormwater/Mitigation will be addressed.

The construction documents are complete and we are ready to advertise the contract for bids. The advertisement is contained in the attached "Notice to Contractors".

COMMUNITY OUTREACH:

This project is included in the adopted 2013-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP development undergoes a wide array of public input processes, including public hearings, open house meetings, and an internet web site.

BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

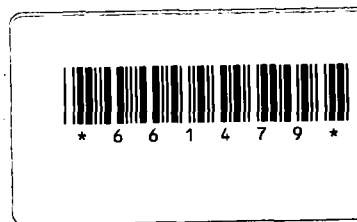
There are no budget or policy implications associated with this request. The 2013 Annual Construction Program includes this project (item Number 2).

I.A - Explanation of what the request does that has fiscal impact and the assumptions for developing revenue and costing information.

The NE 10th Avenue (NE 141st Street to NE 149th Street) project will improve NE 10th Avenue to a standard 2-lane collector with center turn lane, bike lanes, sidewalks, curb, gutter, and shoulders. Stormwater/Mitigation will be addressed.

The total cost for construction is estimated at \$3,464,000.

This project is programmed in the 2013-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2013 Annual Construction Program (Item 2). The revenues and expenses for this project are currently included in the 2013/2014 budget.

All bids shall be delivered to the attention of the Clark County Purchasing, P.O. Box 5000, Vancouver, Washington 98666-5000 or 1300 Franklin Street, Suite 650. Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope, marked "Sealed Bid", which clearly states the name of the bidder, the project number, the project title, the date of the bid opening, and appropriate wording to indicate definitely the nature of the contents. Do not send bids by FAX or email. Bids submitted by FAX or email will not be accepted.

A bid proposal deposit, made in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid proposal, shall accompany all bid proposals. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Clark County Road Fund.

The right is reserved by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the call for bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the Contracting Agency is served.

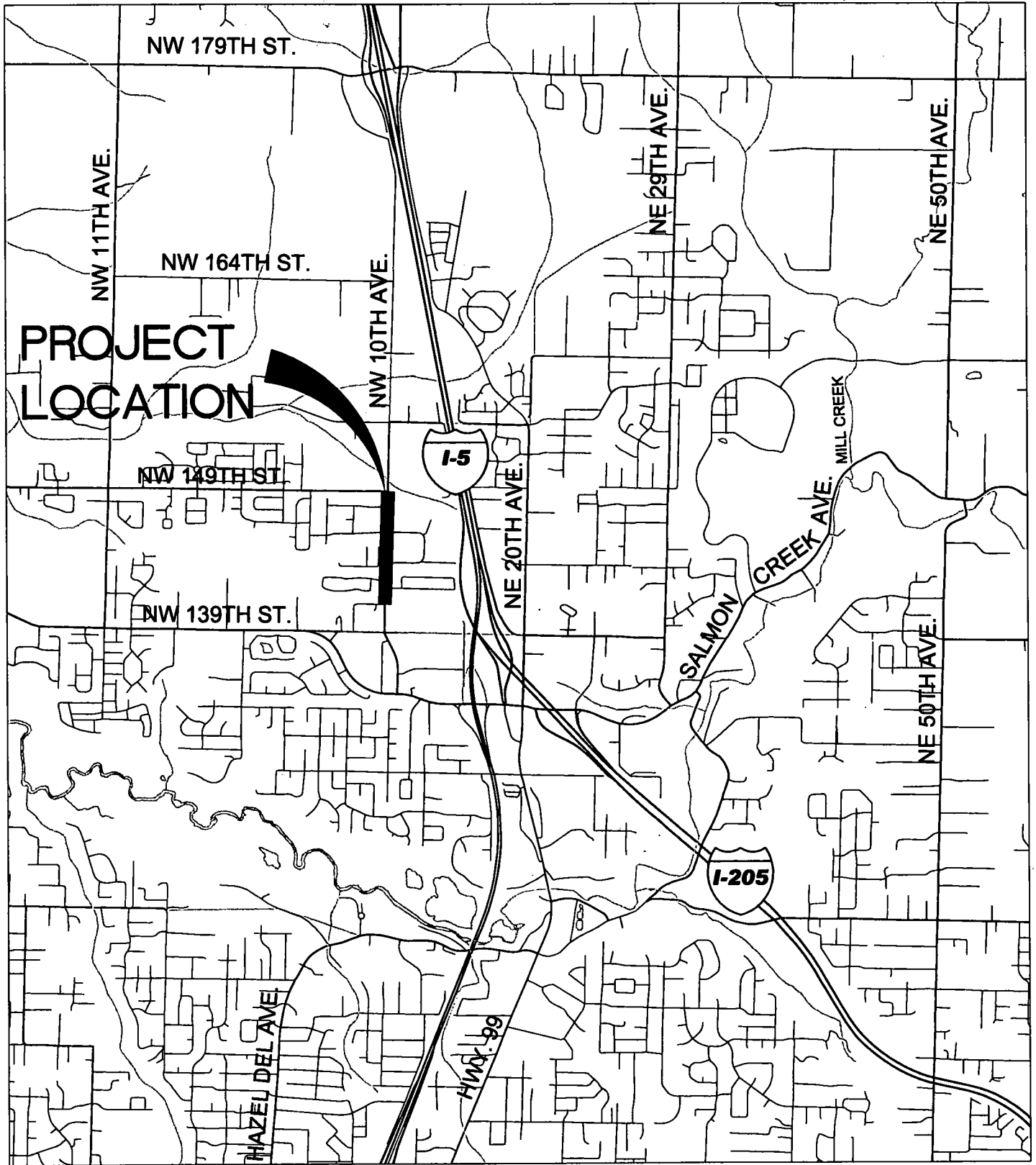
