## RIDGEFIELD JUNCTION NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

## BY-LAWS

- 1. The PURPOSE of this not for profit organization is to preserve, protect, improve and enhance the quality, character and the economy of the Ridgefield and North Clark County area.
- 2. BOUNDARIES: 319th Street on the North, 50th Avenue to the East, 219th Street is the South boundary and Lake River on the West.
- 3. MEMBERSHIP: All residents, property owners, businesses and parties interested in the area are eligible for membership.
- 4. MEMBERSHIP FEES: Membership fees are voluntary and not a condition for participation or voting.
- 5. MEETINGS: The Association will hold a minimum of one annual meeting per year. Additional meetings will be called when the Officers and Board of Directors feel it is necessary.
- 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The general members of the association will elect a board of not less than ten and not more than twelve members. Each year at the annual meeting, as their terms expire, one-third of the directors shall be elected for a three-year term.
- 7. CONDUCT OF AFFAIRS: The Board of Directors is granted the authority to conduct all business affairs for the Association. They may adopt, alter or repeal the Ridgefield Junction Association By-Laws. There will be a minimum of two Board of Directors meetings per year.
- 7. OFFICERS: The President and Vice-President will be elected from members of the Board of Directors. The Secretary and Treasurer may be elected from the Board of Directors or appointed from the general membership. All officers serve one year terms, but may be re-elected.
- 8. DUTIES OF OFFICERS: The President will preside over both the general meetings and the Board of Directors meetings. The Vice-President will preside in the absence of the President. The Secretary will take minutes of both the general and the Board of Directors meetings. The Treasurer will collect and deposit fees and disburse payment for expenses approved by the Board of Directors.
