2:20– 2:45 p.m.	<b>Discussion</b>	<p><b>Questions/Suggestions asked after presentation:</b></p> <p><b>What will be the process after a report is issued?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CCPH will help the schools prioritize items to be addressed.</li> </ul> <p><b>Where are the reports published to?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They are internal; however they would be public record. Reports can go to whomever the district likes.</li> </ul> <p><b>Change name from inspection to consultation.</b></p> <p><b>Minimize statutes noted in reports.</b></p> <p><b>Green Mountain is a much smaller school and feels that the fee is too high. Fees are based on the time other LHJ have indicated the inspections take.</b></p> <p><b>What areas of the schools will be inspected?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student occupied locations, such as but not limited to classrooms, common areas, and cafeterias, will be inspected.</li> </ul> <p><b>How long would the on-site inspection take?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This depends and we are hoping the volunteer year will help us establish this better.</li> </ul>





		<p><b>Does someone need to walk with inspectors during inspections?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each location can decided if they want someone walking with the inspector. At the end of the inspection there would be a meeting to discuss findings before report is sent.</li> </ul> <p><b>What about work practices?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Things like eye protections, hair restraint, safe zones yes but not ergonomics.</li> </ul> <p><b>Some of the things on the checklist are duplicated in other inspections by other agencies. It will take a long time to cover all items in checklist.</b></p> <p><b>CCPH asked the districts to red line the inspection document with any changes they would like to see and send it to them for consideration.</b></p>
