2022 Tax Collection

We had a successful year of tax collections, ending with a collection rate of 99.18%! The tax role of 2023 totals \$898,201,770.13; bills will be sent out in late February 2023.

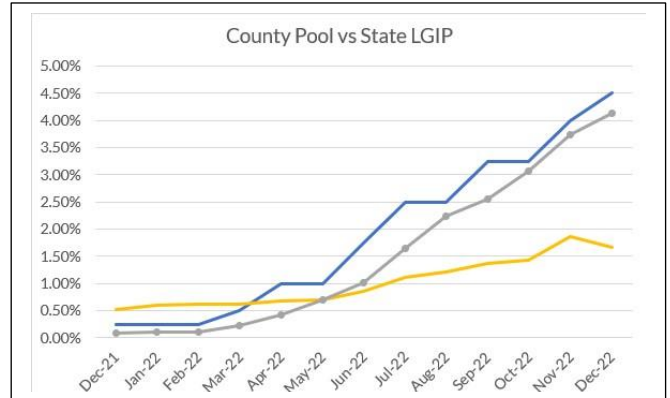


Treasurer's Office Highlights

Investment Pool Updates

The Clark County Investment Pool (CCIP) had an average balance of \$1.14B in 2022 and average interest earnings rate of 1.03%. The CCIP has earned \$15.2M over the State Investment Pool in the last 10 years!
