	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	You have a couple of links for a plan holder list. As long as we're listed on there, there's no attachment B needed.	If you are already listed on the plan holder list, you do not need to submit Attachment B.
2.	Could you please clarify if the special projects are included in the annual budget? Or are these case by case?	They are case by case. Special projects can include, for example, replacement of pumps. We've evaluated looking at the replacing the gas system, the lines entirely, and updating the gas system, as well as right now the there's a 99th St. project going to the North, and we provide engineering support to that, regarding its impacts to the landfill. And the City of Vancouver is already in the planning phase for a \$150 million public Works Operations Center, which is a directly adjacent to the landfill at the South end. The 30 acres that they purchased used to be part of the landfill site, it's still within the consent decree. So those are some examples of special projects that are added by the Oversight Committee.
3.	I wanted to confirm that the annual budget that was provided in the RFP, the rough one. Those special projects are outside of that. Is that correct?	Yes, that is correct. That was the baseline budget for the last few years for the M&M portion of the project.
4.	Could you confirm if This site is a hazardous waste site or MSW?	Yes, it's on the list. It's a hazardous waste cleanup site to five or something like that state list. You can find all the information through department of Ecologies website.
