Question #15: Section 1 of 9-14.2(1)Topsoil Type A requires that the topsoil

contain 10% Organic Matter at a minimum.

Section 9 of 9-14.2(1)Topsoil Type A states that the non-soil

components must be less than 1% by volume.

Question - Can the topsoil be amended w/compost or is compost

considered "non-soil"?

(It is very difficult to source a topsoil with Organic Matter higher

than 5% on its own.)

Ouestion #16: Full Intersection Closure - NE 119th Street and NE 152nd: The

closure duration (July 1 - August 31) doesn't appear to allow the contractor/subcontractors enough time to complete all of the work outlined in the contract documents without working additional shifts or overtime. We are requesting the full closure be extended as much as possible to allow enough time to safely

complete the work.
