3) FIP Updates – Justin Collell

- a) Recap of Outreach – 1,154 visitors to the Home and Garden Idea Fair
- b) Garlic mustard – Same extent of infestations with some improvement, City of Camas owns a lot along the greenway, and they are using a contractor
- c) Poison hemlock – Good growing conditions so plants are healthy, BNB has done a good first round of control and we will continue to follow up
- d) Variable-leaf Milfoil – Tsugawa Brothers had work done by a contractor who had permit for herbicide treatments, Permit transferred to Clark County for our treatments and will then be transferred back, government agencies can have many water bodies on the same permit, we are set to treat six smaller water bodies, Randy mentioned Townsend is trying to starve the milfoil out in Warren Seely
 - i) There will be EDRR training in August – may initially get reports of parrot feather and native milfoil
- e) Tansy ragwort – Signs are ready to be put up
