	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	Is the event center open to alcoholic beverage service provided by a licensed contractor or is that something strictly prohibited?	We already have a contract with a service provider who provides alcoholic beverage service. At this time we are only in need of a service provider for food and non-alcoholic beverages.
2.	How much of the equipment will be left in the concession stands for the selected service provider to use?	All of the large appliances are the property of Fairgrounds Site Management Group and will be left when the previous service provider vacates the concession stands. The current service provider has stated that he is willing to sell pieces of equipment to the selected service provider.
3.	Is there a walk-in freezer or a walk-in storage room in the Hall C concession stand?	No, the only walk-in storage is located in the Hall A concession stand. The Hall C concession stand contains portable refrigerators, freezers, and storage cabinets.
4.	Will anyone else have access to the assigned spaces?	Once a service provider is selected, access to the assigned spaces will be limited to the service provider and their staff, County Facilities staff members, and select FSMG staff members.
