1.	<p>Pre-Submittal – Onsite Meeting involved a walking tour of Halls A, B, C, Equestrian Arena, Backside of Grandstands, Frontside of Grandstands and Parking Lot A fence line. A site map was provided that had a listing of all electrical service panels located on site (see each individual red circle).</p>	<p>A map was provided to all attendees and is titled <u>Question 1 - Fairgrounds Complex – CC Facilities Management Electrical Service/Panel Map.pdf</u></p> <p>For those not in attendance, this map has been available for review.</p> <p>The meeting started at approximately 1:10pm and concluded at approximately 2:05pm.</p>
2.	<p>What equipment and materials are provided to the awarded contractor by Clark County Facilities or FSMG for general use in support of events or the Clark County Fair (spider boxes was example stated)?</p>	<p>As per the RFP, Section 1A, 3. Scope of Project, c. Contractor must acquire and maintain an inventory of equipment sufficient to provide complete electrical services for any and all events that may be contracted by the Event Center while at the same time servicing any and all other contracts to other facilities and event s that may be present. All electrical equipment (components/devices) will be UL listed and meet all city and state electrical codes and requirements.</p>
3.	<p>Where does the installation responsibility of the contractor start in regard to providing electrical services for events and the Clark County Fair?</p>	<p>All electrical infrastructure that is permanently installed and in place is the responsibility of Clark County Facilities Management to maintain and keep in good working order. All permanent infrastructure site request & improvements are the responsibility of Clark County Facilities management. Any electrical issues that are found by the contractor at an access point of a permanent electrical service, a request to FSMG and/or Facilities Management staff will be submitted by the contractor and the shortfall will be addressed promptly.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the contractor to provide for electrical services that are desired by contracted events and the Clark County Fair. Each electrical service requested of the contractor will start at each point of permanent electrical service and will run to each requested end user. It will be the responsibility of the electrical contractor to maintain each installed electrical</p>

		service for the contracted duration of the event or Clark County Fair.
4.	What type of events are held at the Event Center and on grounds that need electrical support?	<p>A paper copy listing by month was provided on site for review by each participating Pre-Submittal – Onsite Meeting attendee.</p> <p>A digital copy is being provided as part of the Q & A process and is named <u>Question 4 - 2024 Events List with Electrical Support Requests Y-Yes N-No. pdf</u>.</p> <p>Current scheduled events can be reviewed on the website at Clark County Event Center at the Fairgrounds at the following link: https://www.clarkcoeventcenter.com/events</p> <p>It was also explained that in the event services business, electrical service requests and needs can vary from event to event. There is also no guarantee that an event will want to contract for electrical services. Also, recurring events may have different electrical service requests for each specific event.</p> <p>Due to the nature of this work, there is no guarantee on the scope and number of electrical requests for any given event.</p> <p>There are also no guarantees on the number or types of events that will take place at the Clark County Event Center and/or its grounds.</p> <p>During the COVID 19 pandemic, the Clark County Fair was not held for two consecutive years.</p>
5.	What are the requirements for Electrical needs for the carnival area at the Clark County Fair?	<p>The contractor that provides carnival area services is self-supporting and is independent operations. The contractor that is awarded the work as defined in this RFP will not be providing any services to this slice of the Clark County Fair.</p>
6.
