

PROPOSAL

The Planning Commission will consider a proposal to repeal subsection 5 of section 2 of Ordinance 2022-07-01 related to CPZ 2021-00006 Chelatchie Bluff which added a Surface Mining Overlay (SMO) to four parcels totaling 330 acres. This proposed action is in response to the Court of Appeals decision affirming the Growth Management Hearings Board Final Order that concluded that the county's action to add the overlay did not comply with the Growth Management Act and is invalid as interfering with the GMA goals due to a SEPA violation.
