

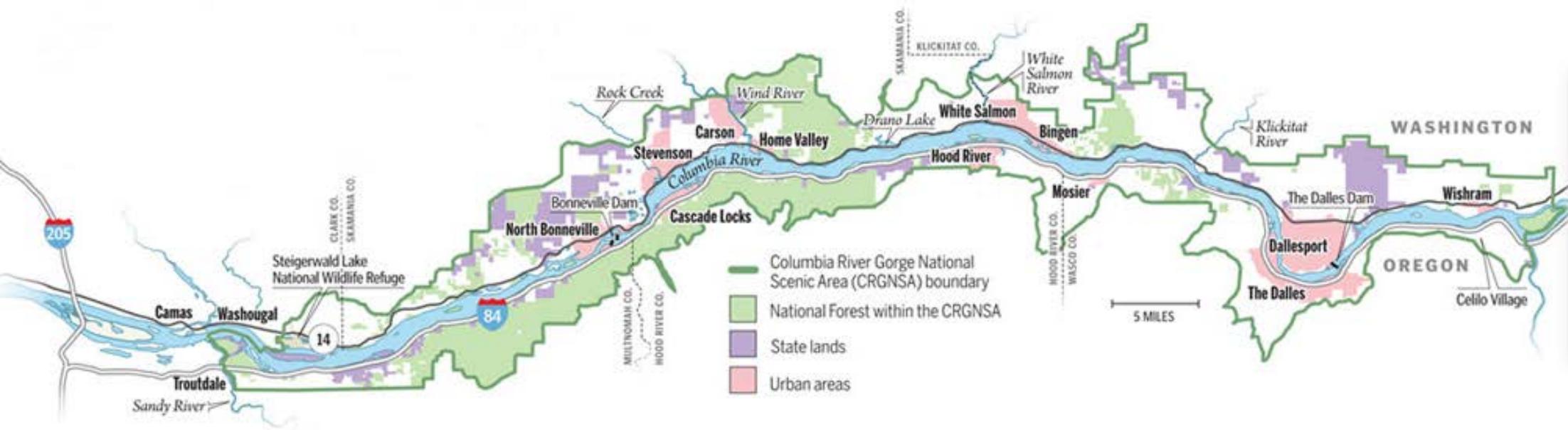

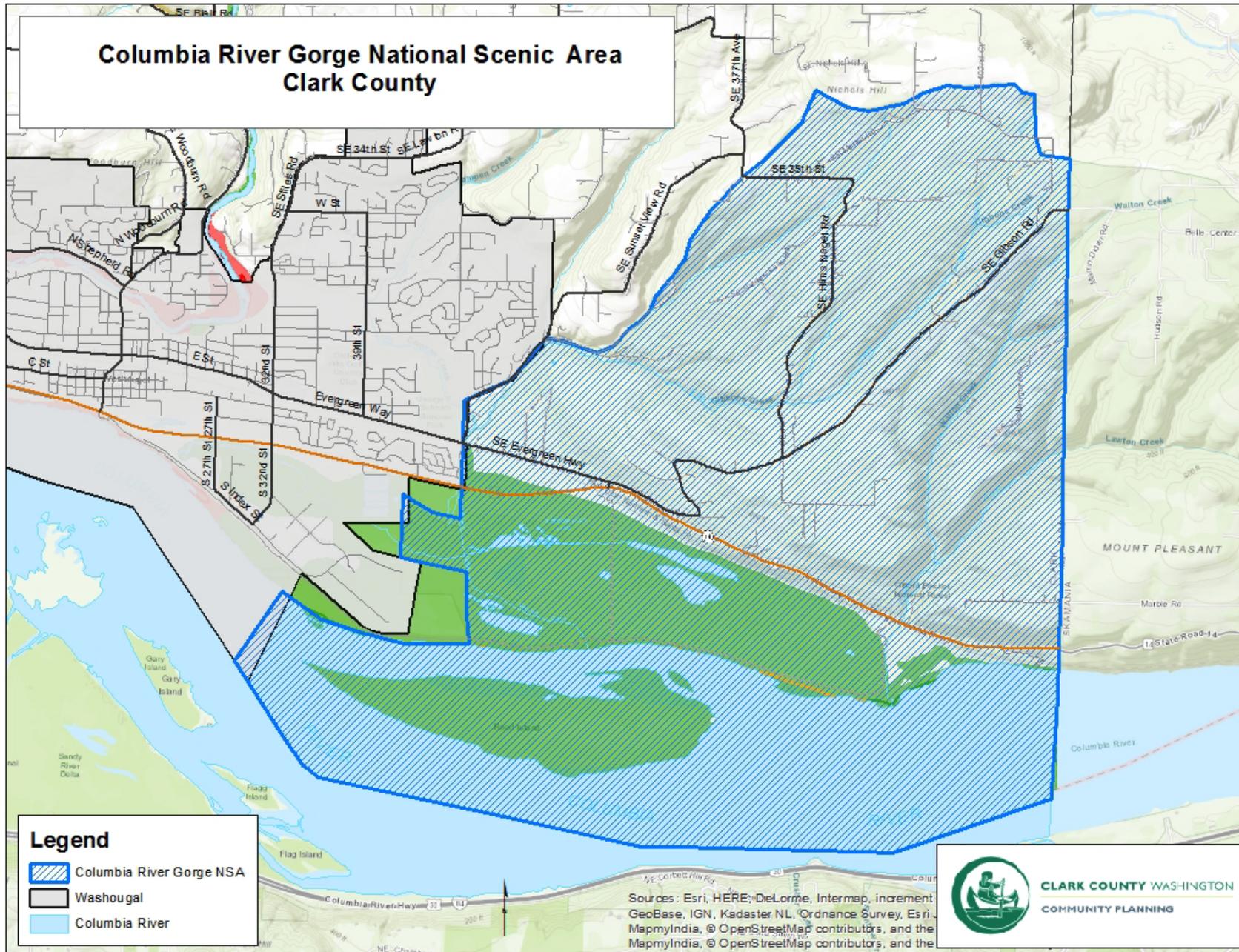

- Must be conducted if any element of any land use application requires a survey
- May be conducted even if a proposed use falls within an exemption

- Review of the cumulative effects of development applications
- An analysis of potential impacts to scenic and natural resources

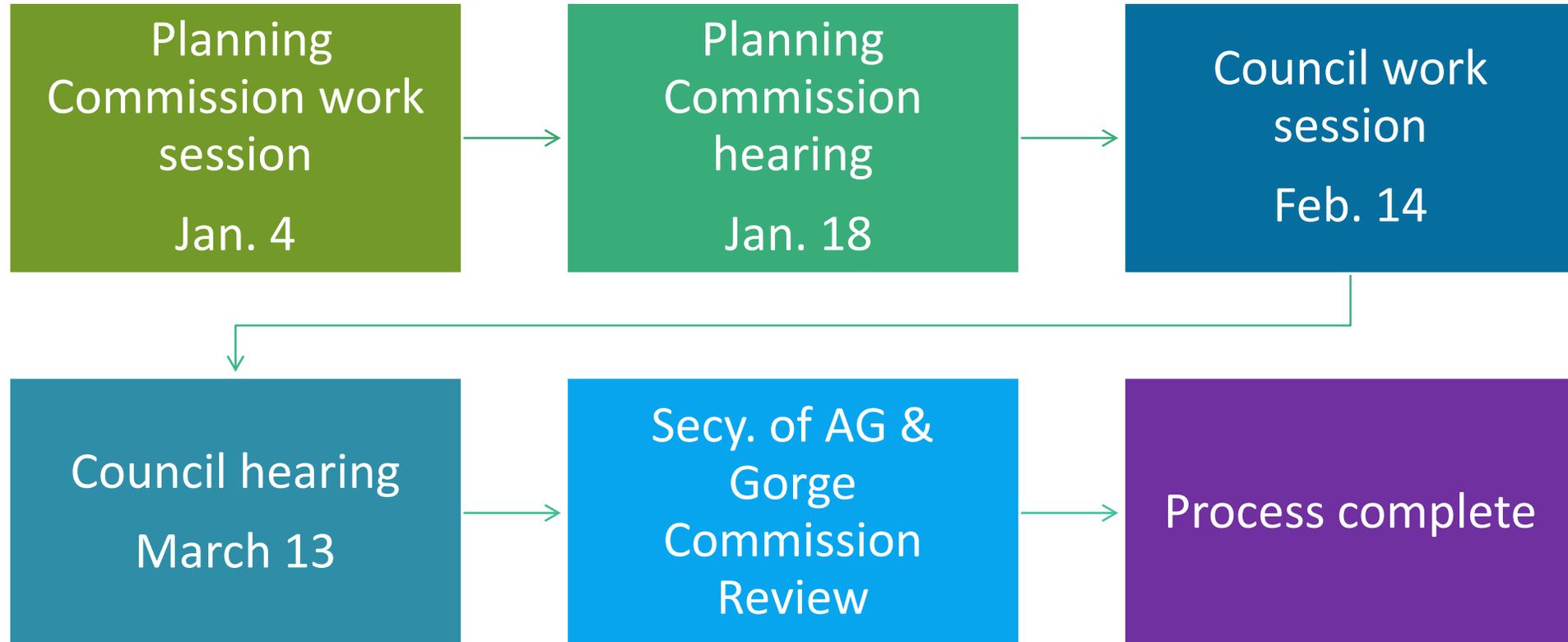

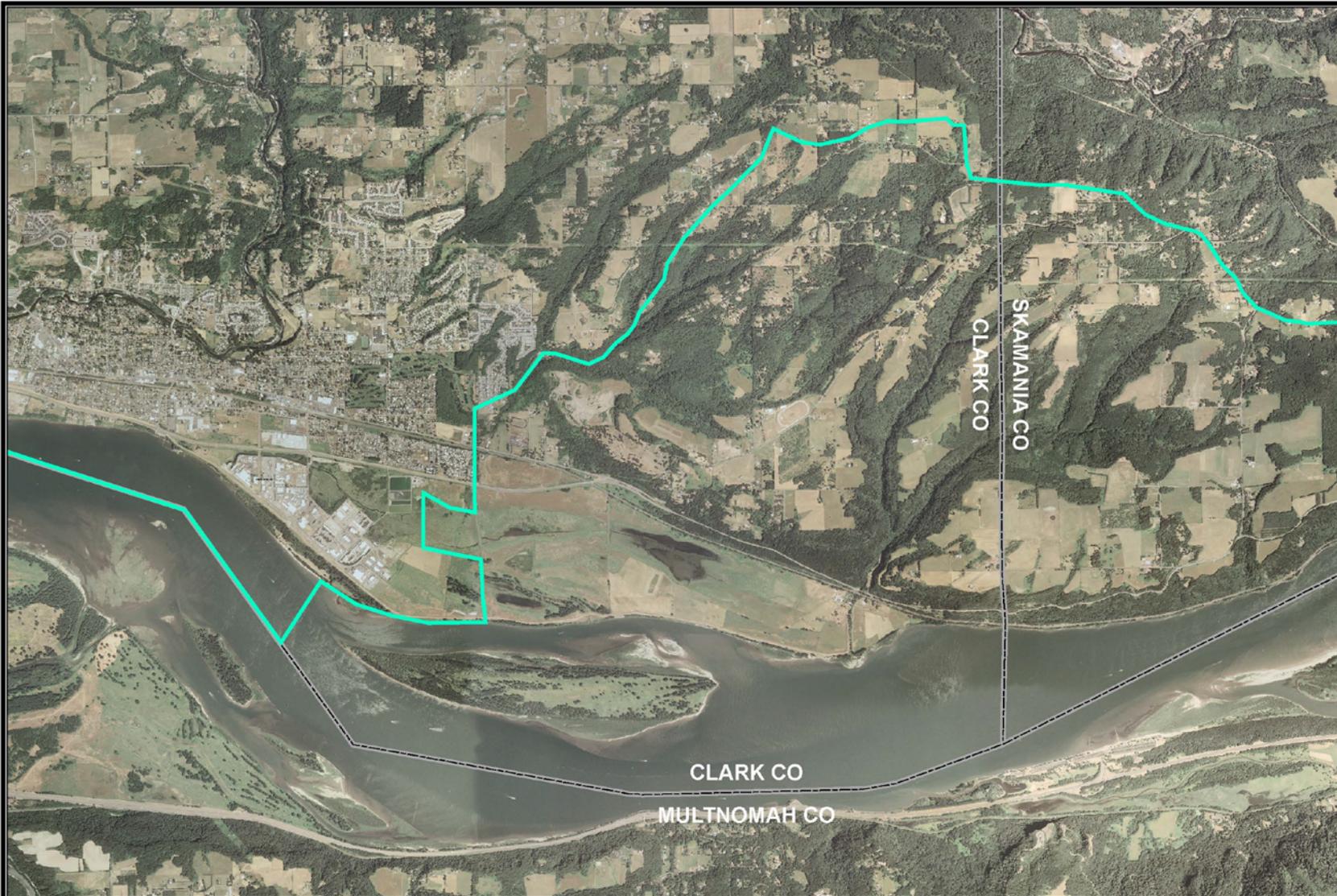

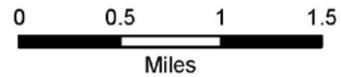
