Legal Requirements:

RCW 36.81 and WAC 136

All capital road projects are to be in ACP/TIP.


County Engineer to "develop and apply" priority programming.

Council adopts before budget – Council action required to later amend TIP.

TIP follows adopted policies and Comprehensive Plan via the Capital Facilities Plan.



Risks and Unknowns:

- Proposed REET2 Programmed for 2019/2020
- Five year gap in state funding for 179th Street area improvements
- ▶ \$10M PWTF loan for NE 10th Avenue
- Know if we get additional grants by September and November
- Volatility of TIF revenues. Assume current revenues rate, with an increase in the TIF forecast
- Reassess TIP revenues/expenditures annually
