BACKGROUND

Evergreen Habitat for Humanity, Clark County Public Health, City of Vancouver, and over 40 multisectoral partners are focused on reducing the health and economic disparities experienced by families living on the Fourth Plain corridor. The goal of this project is to prevent or mitigate the negative impacts of unaffordable, substandard, and unstable housing to positively impact the mental health status of residents living along the corridor. This will be done through four intentional, systemic interventions: strengthening local data infrastructure, local legislative advocacy, policy assessment and implementation, and training local leaders to promote sustainable, healthy neighborhood development.
