## **NOTE TO VOTERS**

This sample ballot contains all candidates who have filed for office and will appear at the Primary Election on September 15th. You will **not** be entitled to vote on all races and issues that appear on this ballot. When you go to the polls only the Legislative and County Commissioner and other local contests that apply to your precinct will be listed.

Also, state law requires that candidates names be rotated on the official ballot so that each name appears at the top position an equal number of times. Candidates are listed on the Sample and Absentee ballots in an order determined by lot. When you go to the polls on election day the candidates names may not be listed on the official ballot in the same order that you find them in this sample ballot.

You are entitled to mark and take this ballot to the polls with you.

The polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
