CLARK COUNTY GREATER CLARK PARKS DISTRICT

PROPOSITION NO. 1 GREATER CLARK PARKS DISTRICT

Authorizes the creation of a Metropolitan Park District with boundaries defined as the Vancouver unincorporated urban growth area. The District, if formed, would levy a general tax up to twenty-seven cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to allow for such park and trail development by providing maintenance funding.

Simple majority (50% + 1 vote) to pass and no validation requirements.

**PROPOSITION NO. 1 HOCKINSON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 98
 SCHOOL PROGRAM LEVY**

Authorize excess taxes be levied on all taxable property within the district for three years.

At least 1,067 total YES votes cast to validate and 60% or higher (super majority) YES votes to pass.
