PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING RESTORATION OF PREVIOUS PROPERTY TAX LEVIES

The Board of Commissioners of Clark County Fire Protection District 12 adopted Resolution No. 070522-1 concerning a proposition to restore its regular property tax levy to retain their Paramedic program and for maintenance and operations to an amount not to exceed \$1.41 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2008 and to authorize setting the limit factor at 100% plus the percentage change in Consumer Price Index For All Urban Consumers for the Portland Metropolitan Area (1982-84=100) reported for August of the levy year for each of five succeeding years.
