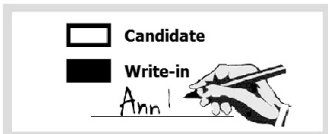


Incorrect

Use a blue or black pen to completely fill in the box to the left of your choice.

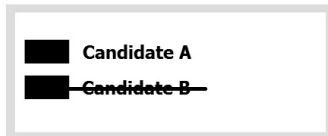
Vote for one choice for each office. If you vote for more than one choice for that office, no votes will be counted for that office.

WHEN RETURNING YOUR BALLOT

Put a first class stamp (\$0.49) on the envelope and mail it on or before election day, Tuesday, August 4. Your ballot must be postmarked no later than election day, so check the pick-up schedule on the mail box or confirm election day hours with the post office.

If you return your ballot to a drop site location, it must be returned by 8:00 PM on Tuesday, August 4, for it to be counted.
