

**Ballot Measure Validation & Passage Requirements
February 14, 2012 Special Election**

Evergreen School District No. 114 – Proposition No. 1 - Four Year School Program Replacement Levies

- There are no validation requirements for this school excess levy ballot measure
- Requires a simple majority (50% plus one vote) of YES votes to pass

Ridgefield School District No. 122 – Proposition No. 1 – General Obligation Bonds - \$47,000,000

- 1,826 total votes cast on the proposition for it to validate
- a 60% or higher YES vote to pass

Hockinson School District No. 98 – Proposition No. 1 – Four Year Replacement of Expiring School Programs and Operations Levy

- There are no validation requirements for this school excess levy ballot measure
- Requires a simple majority (50% plus one vote) of YES votes to pass

Hockinson School District No. 98 – Proposition No. 2 – Four Year Replacement of Expiring Capital Levy for Technology and School Improvements

- There are no validation requirements for this school excess levy ballot measure
- Requires a simple majority (50% plus one vote) of YES votes to pass

Woodland School District No. 404-102 – Proposition No. 1 – Two Year Replacement Educational Maintenance and Operations Levy

- There are no validation requirements for this school excess levy ballot measure
- Requires a simple majority (50% plus one vote) of YES votes to pass

Green Mountain School District No. 103 – Proposition No. 1 – Four Year Replacement Maintenance of Operations Levy

- There are no validation requirements for this school excess levy ballot measure
- Requires a simple majority (50% plus one vote) of YES votes to pass
