Presidential Primary Instructions

For your vote to count, you **must**:

- Mark **one** party box on the return envelope.
- Vote for **one** candidate of the **same** party marked.
- Sign and return the declarations on your return envelope no later than Election Day.

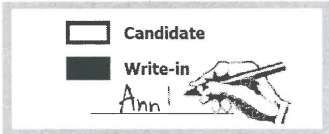
For more detailed instructions refer to the instruction sheet that came with your ballot.



Use a blue or black pen to completely fill in the box to the left of your choice.

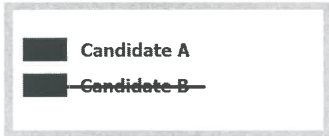
If you vote for more than one candidate or mark both party boxes on the return envelope, no votes will be counted.

To vote for a Write-in candidate:



Completely fill in the box to the left of the words "Write-in" and write the name of the candidate on the line.

To correct a mistake:



Draw a line through the entire candidate's name as shown above. You then have the option of marking another choice.
