

RESOLUTION NO. 893

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Vancouver School District No. 37, Clark County, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the district at a special election to be held therein on February 14, 2023, of propositions to levy general taxes upon the taxable property within the school district in excess of the constitutional and statutory limitations. A replacement education and operations levy shall be made in 2023 for collections in 2024, 2025, 2026 and 2027, the proceeds thereof to be credited to the general fund of Vancouver School District No. 37 to provide revenue required to assist in improving the general education program. Said proposition to read as follows:

Proposition #6: Shall a four-year replacement education and operations levy for Vancouver School District No. 37, be collected to maintain and operate general education programs in the amount of \$61,661,200 (collected in 2024 at approximately \$1.99 per \$1,000 assessed valuation), \$65,308,600 (collected in 2025 at approximately \$1.99 per \$1,000 assessed valuation), \$69,985,300 (collected in 2026 at approximately \$1.99 per \$1,000 assessed valuation), and \$74,988,200 (collected in 2027 at approximately \$1.99 per \$1,000 assessed valuation).

WHEREAS, Vancouver School District No. 37, (“District”), does not have sufficient local funds to meet all its needs; therefore,

IT IS RESOLVED that it has been determined an emergency does exist and the District Board of Directors finds it necessary to ask the Clark County Auditor to place before the voters a Special Levy election in the district on February 14, 2023, for general fund expenses in the amount of \$61,661,200 in 2024, \$65,308,600 in 2025, \$69,985,300 in 2026 and \$74,988,200 in 2027.

The Clark County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in Clark County, Washington, is hereby requested to call and conduct a special election to be held within the District on February 14, 2023, and to submit to the qualified electors of the district the proposition hereinafter set forth.

The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby authorized and directed to certify such proposition substantially in the following form:

SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS

The Board of Directors of Vancouver School District No. 37 passed Resolution No. 893 concerning this proposition to maintain current educational funding. This proposition authorizes the District to continue funding students' educational needs and school operations by levying the following excess taxes to replace the existing levy on all taxable property within the District, for educational programs and daily operational expenses, including textbooks, classroom materials and staff:






